



Bridge of Hope-Richmond End of Year Report

This year we have completed 39 **NEW** intakes of which two were male clients. Each client is required to take our parenting and prenatal education programs.

Sexual risk avoidance and abstinence education was given when clients came in for STD/STI testing. These tests included:

- Chlamydia
- Gonorrhea
- Syphilis

Please note that these sessions are included as part of the intake process and not in a classroom setting.

In order for our families to benefit from our boutique, they must first take part in our **Earn While you Learn** program. The subscription for this program which we pay for (Bright Course) is \$69/month which provides 10 to 30-minute classes sent to our clients via their phones. Every time they view a class, we assign a “Baby Buck” to them which enables them to shop our boutique.

We hosted two Community Baby Showers this year in conjunction with Home State Health. Many pregnant Mom’s took advantage of these.

Lastly, I’d like to express our thanks for your continued support. The services we provide through your generosity sustain our mission – advocating for the family. However, the cost of doing business has gone up so to help us offset the increased costs, would you prayerfully consider an increase in your support? Any increase would be significant to our mission. Also, we are very short on volunteers. It takes two volunteers per day, five days a week to keep this office running.
